This quarter our spotlight is on Lora Pickard.

We recently caught up to talk about Business Analysis. Here are some responses from our interview with Lora.

What's your favourite part about being a Business Analyst?

There are a few things that do it for me - the challenge of making complex problems and needs understandable, the opportunity to learn about how things work outside of my own domain, and collaborating with so many diverse people and roles.

How do you know when you're doing a good job as a successful Business Analyst?

When an end user or subject matter expert asks how long I've worked in their role or industry because I understand what they do so well. Makes me happy they think I know my stuff! As part of my different roles, I get to work with a diverse group of interesting people that have multitude of challenges whether it be people, process, tools and likely a combination of all three. Everyday I get to collaborate with my customers and my team to help innovate and meet customer objectives. All of this is very satisfying.

What do you like best about the IIBA Winnipeg Chapter?

Being part of a community that wants to grow their BA skills and the BA practice overall. Our chapter allows us to participate in great speaker and networking events, conferences, and training opportunities, all with like-minded BA professionals.

In your opinion, what is the single most important characteristic of a successful Business Analyst in Winnipeg?

Listening. But not listening in order to respond; listening in order to understand. This uncovers the real requirements beyond what a stakeholder will tell you they need. For me, this helps build a trusted relationship with the stakeholder and a better result that meets their actual requirements.

What trend in our market will most strongly influence the role of BAs in the next 5 years?

I think the emergence of Big Data will influence the role of the BA, applying predictive analytics to solve business issues in a much bigger way than we do today. BAs will not only be analyzing data, but translating insights and patterns found within data into language the business can understand and turn into tangible business value.
